Challenges

- Consistent Patient Education
- Consistent Workforce Education (Primary and secondary care)
- TTA Pack sizes
- Consistent of Transfer of Care including information transfer and follow up in community



Other challenges


- Reduction in supra-therapeutic doses
- Polypharmacy
- Workforce pressures Time to care & effectively educating patients
- Current 'cultural practices' around prescribing and patient expectations
- Limitations with integrated care records

Current steps in secondary care

- Targeting the initiation of Opioids
 - Limit the duration of treatment post operatively Hard stops
 - Educate patients Supplement with written information
- Discharge information
 - Clear communication to GP and Community Pharmacy
 - Utilise Community and PCN / GP pharmacists
